1 ELIGIBILITY

The regatta shall be conducted for the following classes (minimum three entries required to constitute a class):

INVITED CLASSES (Bravo Course)

1. **B14** Class
2. **NS14** Class
3. **Laser** Class (*Full rig, radial & 4.7 divisions*)
4. **Sabre** Class (*State Championship*)

SABOT (Alpha Course)

1. **One-up, Two-up & Coached divisions** (*State Championship*)

3 ONLINE ENTRY AND FEES

Eligible boats must enter online at <https://pdyc.yachting.org.au/home> with the Organizing Authority by **Friday 16th February 2024** with the required entry fee. Late entries will be accepted until 10:30am on Saturday 18th February 2023 subject to a late fee of \$20.

The entry fees for the regatta are:

Invited Classes	\$50.00
Sabot - Standard entry	\$30.00
- Family with two boats	\$40.00
- First time regatta in coached division	\$20.00

4 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 – 2024 (RRS), the prescriptions of Australian Sailing (AS), applicable class rules (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions for all classes will be available from the Port Dalrymple Yacht Club web page, from Thursday 15th February or at the briefing to be held at 1100 on Saturday 17th February.

6 RACING AREA AND COURSES

Racing will be conducted on the Tamar River in the vicinity of the Port Dalrymple Yacht Club on two separate course areas:

Alpha Course Area	Invited Classes
Bravo Course Area	Sabot State Championship

The course configurations to be sailed will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

7 SCORING

The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A, will apply. The number of races to be discarded will be specified in the sailing instructions.

8 RESULTS AND HANDICAPS

Invited Classes:

Results for the invited classes will be determined on a scratch basis.

11 SAFETY CATEGORY

All competitors must comply with AS Addendum A-Part 2 as modified by any applicable class rules

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as per the following table

Number of Entrants	3 (or less)	4 to 5	6 or more
Prizes	1st Only	1st & 2nd	1st to 3rd

Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority or each applicable Class Association. The presentation of prizes will be conducted as soon as practicable after the conclusion of racing on Sunday 18th February.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

All those participating in the regatta races do so entirely at their own risk and responsibility. Attention is drawn to RRS rule 3, Decision to Race, which states that the responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.

The Port Dalrymple Yacht Club, its flag officers, committees, servants, volunteers and agents and all other parties involved with the conduct and organisation of the event disclaim any and every responsibility for loss, damage, injury, death or inconvenience that might occur to persons or property, both ashore or afloat, as a consequence of participation in the regatta covered by this notice of race and by the sailing instructions.

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 (recommended \$10,000,000) per event or equivalent.
